Duration: 12 to 18 months. 34 academic credits (1326 contact hours).

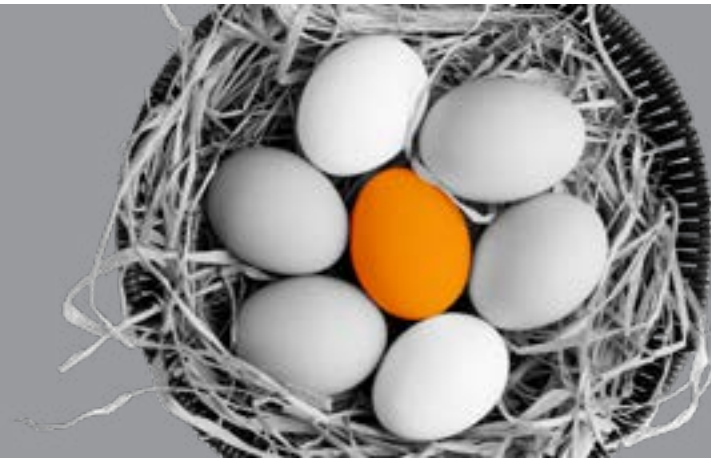

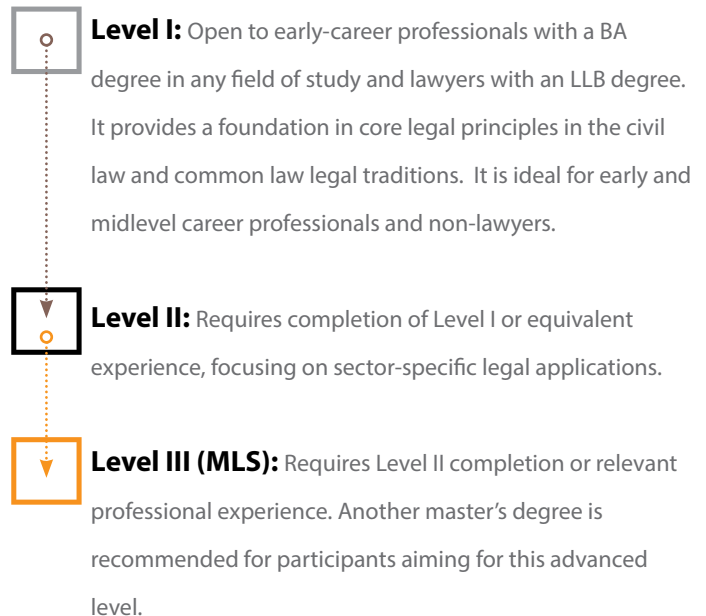

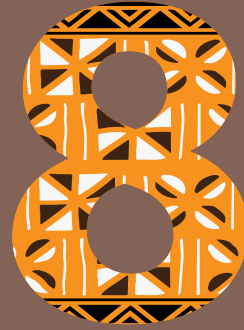
Health Law
